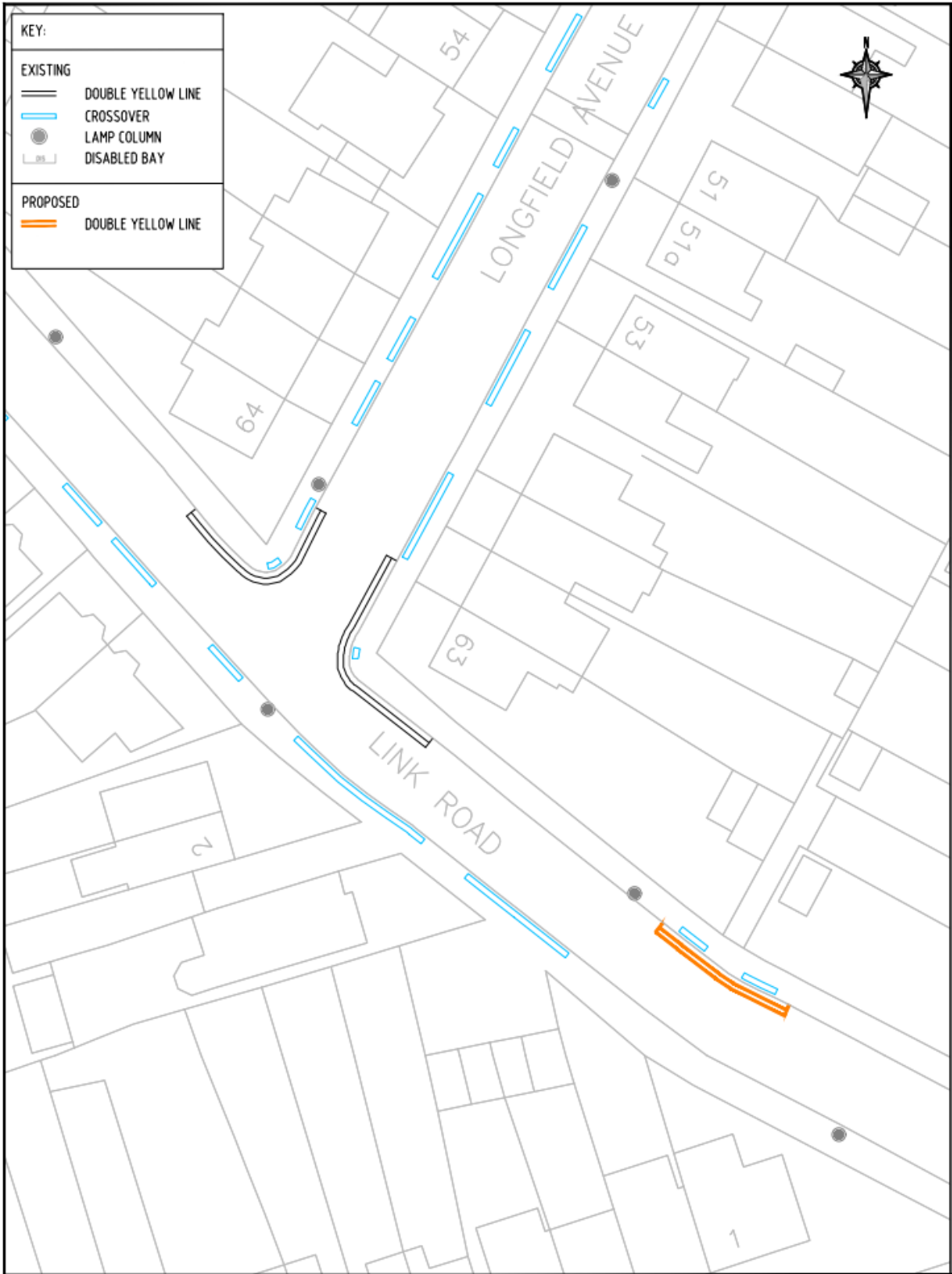
This final stage of consultation will end on **19 October 2023**.
