LONDON LOCAL AUTHORITIES ACT 1990**

**STREET TRADING
STANDARD LICENCE CONDITIONS**

SPECIALITY MARKETS

1. The licence holder, or other such person authorised in writing by the Council, shall trade personally at their licensed pitch
2. The licence holder shall only trade on the days and times shown on their street trading licence
3. The stall used shall be to a design approved by the Council
4. The Licence holder may only store perishable goods in a manner and at a place first approved by the Council for that purpose
5. The Licence holder shall make proper arrangements for the storage and removal of all refuse and litter generated by their trading activities. Licensees shall co-operate with all proper arrangements specified for refuse collection and disposal
6. The Licence holder is responsible at all times for the proper conduct and operation of the licensed activity and shall comply with any proper requirements of an Authorised Officer of the Council.
7. The Licence holder shall remove every receptacle and all goods and other articles from the highway at the end of trading unless written exemption is given by the licensing authority.
8. The Licence holder shall make sure that no disturbance to occupiers of adjacent premises or stalls shall be created by noise, smell, or type of display.
9. The Licence holder shall make sure that at all times, no inconvenience, danger, or obstruction shall be caused to members of the public in any manner whatsoever.
10. The Licence holder shall take out, and maintain at all times, third party public liability insurance cover with a minimum liability of £2,000,000.
11. The Licence holder shall make sure that all trading complies with any relevant legal requirements. In particular, no licensee shall sell counterfeit or otherwise illegal products.
12. The Licence holder shall engage in street trading only in the class and classes of articles, things, or services, shown on their street trading licence
13. The Licence holder shall keep available their copy of the licence at all times and shall present it for inspection when required to do so by an authorised officer of the Council or by a Police Officer
14. The Licence holder shall, at all times, make sure that all electrical, mechanical, and any other equipment whatsoever associated with street trading shall be placed, installed, maintained, and operated in accordance with the provisions of the Health & Safety at Work etc. Act 1974. Certification of safety may be required by the authority on demand. Failure to provide safety certificates may result in the authority requiring the equipment to be removed immediately
