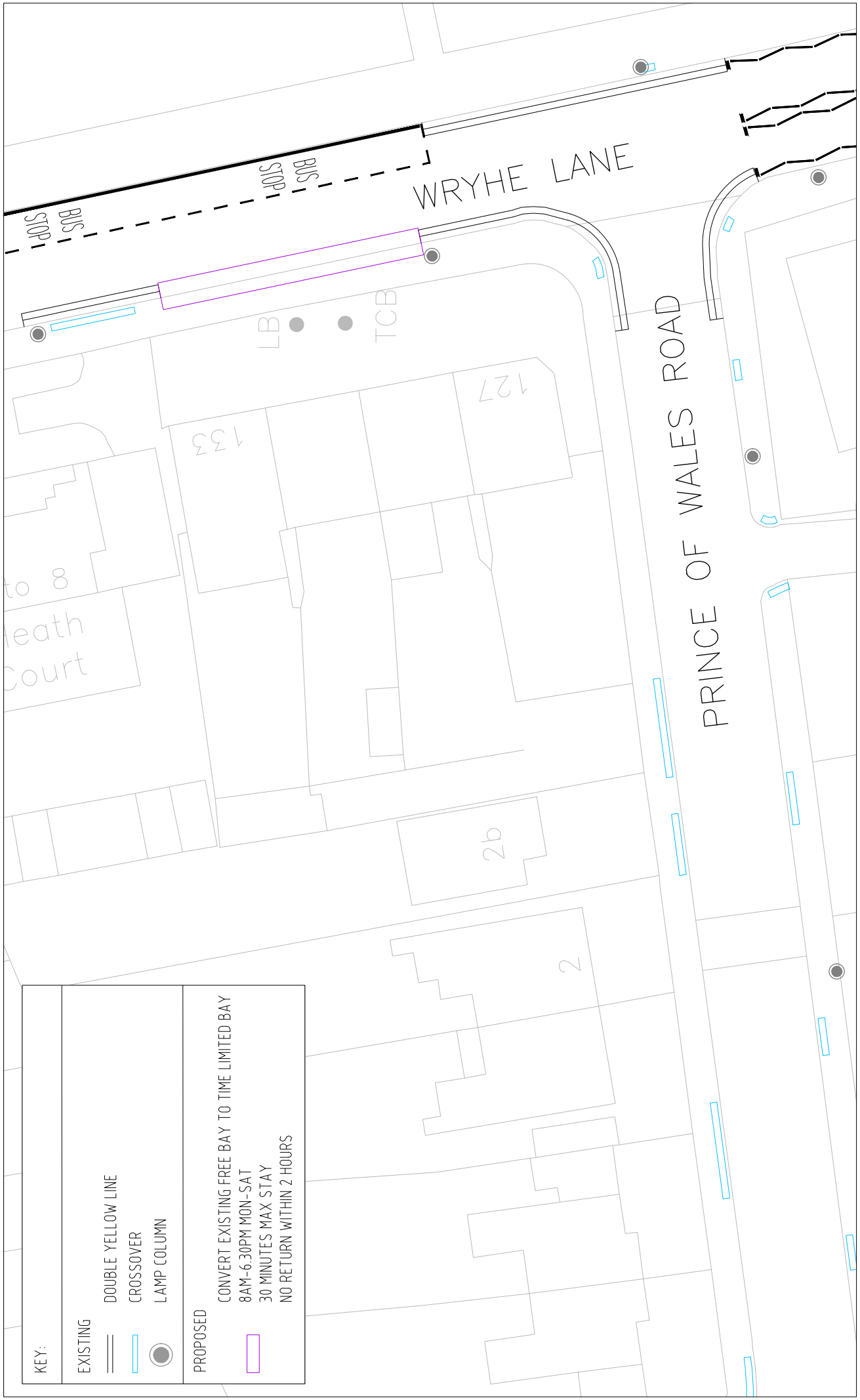
This final stage of consultation will end on **26 September 2024**.
