Proposed parking changes for Hackbridge

Following our consultation in November 2024 and taking feedback from residents and councillors we have now further revised parking proposals for a number of streets in Hackbridge.

The proposals include a number of single yellow line proposals operating Monday to Friday 11am-1pm for the following streets:

- **Bluebell Close**
- **Clover Way**
- **Foxglove Way**
- **Primrose Close**

A small section of double yellow line is proposed at the junction of Foxglove Way and Bluebell Close. A double yellow line extension is proposed at the junction of Clover Way and Poppy Close (**see a detailed map on the back of this letter for more information on the proposals**).
