Proposed parking changes for Stanley Park Road

Following our informal consultation in September 2024 we are now moving to a final consultation about proposed parking changes for your street.

Proposal for Stanley Park Road

Following local requests we are proposing to extend double yellow lines outside and opposite Nos 25a and 25b due to obstructive parking causing safety concerns near the junction. We are also proposing to convert existing single yellow line restrictions (operating Monday to Friday 8am to 6.30pm) to double yellow lines outside Nos 52-56 and No 27 (see detailed map on the back of this letter).
