## **Proposed parking changes for Bisham Close**

We're writing to you as part of our ongoing review of parking in Sutton.

Parking remains one of the issues of most concern to residents in Sutton and we have received many requests for a review of parking arrangements across the borough.

### **Proposal for Bisham Close**

We are proposing the introduction of double yellow lines opposite Nos 10-14 Bisham Close due to obstructive parking. We are also proposing a number of free bay parking bays outside Nos 3-9 Bisham Close to provide maximum parking capacity at the location following reports of inconsiderate parking (**see detailed map on the back of this letter**).
