## **Proposed parking changes for Sparrow Farm Road/Bradstock Road**

Following our informal consultation in December 2023 we are now moving to a final consultation about proposed parking changes for your street.

### **Proposal for Sparrow Farm Road/Bradstock Road**

Following local requests we are proposing to extend double yellow lines outside Nos 71-73 Sparrow Farm Road (near the junction with Bradstock Road) due to obstructive parking causing access and safety issues.

We are also proposing to extend the double yellow lines on Sparrow Farm Road near the junction with Woodstone Ave (to the dropped kerb outside No 74 Sparrow Farm Road) due to obstructive parking causing safety issues **(see detailed map on the back of this letter)**.
