NOTICE is hereby given that a Public Inquiry in connection with the Order mentioned below will be held by an Inspector, appointed for this purpose by the Secretary of State for Transport, **beginning at 10.00 am on 19 November 2019 at Croygas Sports Club, 48 Mollison Drive, Wallington, Surrey SM6 9BY**. This is to hear representations from remaining objectors (as defined in the Compulsory Purchase (Inquiries Procedure) Rules 2007), from any other persons having an interest in the land the subject of the Compulsory Purchase Order and, at his discretion, to hear representations from any other persons who may desire to appear and be heard.

THE ORDER is an Order which has been made by the London Borough of Sutton under the above-mentioned Acts and submitted to the Secretary of State for Transport for confirmation. Namely:-

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF SUTTON (LAND AT BEDDINGTON LANE) COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER 2019.

An Order under sections 239, 240, 246 and 260 of the Highways Act 1980 relating to the improvement of Beddington Lane between Beddington Lane Tramlink stop and the Derry Road junction, including a new north-south cycle track and footway.
